

Although information in the Gamma Zeta scrapbook from 1942 to 1955 indicates that growth was slow and progress was difficult during the early years, these determined women continued to stay focused on the Mission and Purposes of Delta Kappa Gamma. Growth of the chapter by the 1970s allowed a daughter chapter, Iota Upsilon, to be formed in Comanche and Mills Counties and in the mid 1980s the second daughter chapter, Lambda Pi, was formed in Granbury. Now, seventy years later we gather to celebrate those ladies and the work of Gamma Zeta Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma.
